Gosport High Street

- Gosport High Street is a historic market street that has been busy for a very long time.
- You can visit today to see shops, markets, and cafés.

Royal Clarence Yard

- Built in the early 19th century as a major Royal Navy victualling yard, supplying food to ships all over the world.
- Today, the big red-brick buildings are still standing and are full of museums, events, and places to explore.

Priddy's Hard

- Priddy's Hard used to be a busy Navy site where important equipment was made and stored. It helped protect ships and sailors.
- Now it is home to the Explosion Museum, where you can learn about naval history in exciting ways.

Gosport Ferry

- One of the oldest continually operating ferry crossings in the world.
- It still takes people between Gosport and Portsmouth in just a few minutes.

Haslar Sea Wall

- The Haslar Sea Wall runs along the edge of the water and was built to help protect Gosport.
- From here, you can look across the water and see big ships and busy harbours.

Monckton Creek

- Tidal creek near Fort Monckton, historically used for mooring and naval activity.
- Associated with John Deane's pioneering diving experiments.

Gilkicker Lagoon

- A nationally important nature reserve and shingle lagoon.
- Home to all sorts of rare plants, insects, and birdlife.
- The ecological "home ground" of Gilby the Gilkicker Weevil.

Stanley Park

- Victorian park opened in the late 19th century.
- It has big trees, open grass, and is often full of families and events.

Alver Valley Country Park

- Alver Valley is full of paths, water, grass, and wildlife.
- It helps nature stay healthy and protects the land from flooding.

Portsmouth Dockyard

- One of the most important naval dockyards in the world. Symbolising Britain's naval power.
- Visible from Haslar Sea Wall and ferry crossings.

Osborne House

- Queen Victoria's beloved family home on the Isle of Wight.
- Now managed by English Heritage and open to the public.
